The Bett Lauridsen Commuter Centre at VGH

Since 1995, the Cambie Corridor Consortium Society (CCC) has been providing green travel options to the various health authorities in Vancouver. The Commuter Centre is located on the main floor of the Pattison Pavilion at VGH. Its mission is to reduce the number of single occupancy vehicles commuting to the Broadway/Cambie area. Bett Lauridsen, a founding member of the Cambie Corridor Consortium, was the Transportation Coordinator until 2014. Today though, Angelo Longo is the coordinator for the CCC, the responsibility of the Commuter Centre is overseen by the Transportation Services team.

- Outdoor bike cages at VGH
- Carpooling / Car sharing
- Commuter trip planning
- Transit pass program

Inter-Hospital Shuttle Service

Since 1996, the Commuter Centre has operated staff shuttles among various hospital sites in Vancouver. The shuttles are free of charge to staff, faculty, medical students, and on a limited basis, patients and visitors. Shuttle Courier Service

The shuttle will take any items that would normally be sent by outside mail or courier. **All items must have one of our labels, or at the very least, sender & recipient information (including phone numbers).** Call us for information about labels. Rush packages must be handed directly to the driver and the recipient must be notified to pick them up at the destination. Any packages not picked up will be taken to the mailroom after a period of time. For any packages sent to **Womens/Childrens**, the recipient **MUST** pick up their item from the shuttle.

Inter-Hospital Shuttle Courier Service

We also offer a courier service among these same sites. Items can be delivered in as little as 20 minutes. There is **no charge** for this service. Please see the above website for details/restrictions.

Shuttle from MSJ to other sites: Shuttles run from MSJ between 800 & 1600. Pick up is at the main entrance at: 00/:30. The route is MSJ to BCCA to VGH to MSJ. Transfers to other sites occur at VGH. **Please note:** if you are travelling to MSJ **from** St. Pauls, please tell the driver **as soon as you get on**. He will make the necessary arrangements for the connection.

Shuttle between VGH & UBCH: The shuttle leaves VGH (Blackmore Pavilion) & UBCH (across from the main entrance) every half hour from each site, beginning at 7:05. The last shuttles leave VGH at 1635 and UBCH at 17:05. Both the northbound and southbound shuttles connect with the VGH/UBCH shuttle. If you need to connect with one of them, please tell the driver and they will call the connecting shuttle.

Seating priority: Hospital staff, medical staff, medical related grad students, and medical students **on hospital business** have seating priority. Staff/med students going to or from work or class **do not** have priority, but are welcome as space permits. Drivers reserve the right to ask non-priority passengers to give up their seat for 'at work' staff.
