### • Representation Agreements

	RA7	RA9
Also known as:	Standard RA	Enhanced RA
Legal capacity required at time of creation:	Lower threshold on capability (has cognitive difficulties at the time of completing document)	Capable adult
Decision coverage:	All 3 categories: health care, financial/legal, and personal care	Health care and personal care only
Extent of power:	Limited powers within each category (e.g., the representative can pay bills but cannot sell property)	Comprehensive coverage for health and personal care powers, including decisions about life support and relocation. Does not include legal or finances.

### • Committeeship

	Private Committee	Public Guardian
Appointment type	Court order (must hire a lawyer and file an application with the Supreme Court of BC)	Via the health authority (no court order required)
Typical decision- maker for committee of person	Person (typically an adult child)	PGT only
Typical decision- maker for committee of estate	Person, trust company, or credit union	PGT only
Role of PGT	Monitors and reviews the activities of private committees and investigates neglect and/or abuse as required	Committee (decision-maker)
Extent of power:	<ul> <li>Requires 2 physicians to state incapability</li> <li>Expensive</li> <li>Takes up to a year to complete</li> <li>Difficult to reverse</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Requires 2 physicians to state incapability</li> <li>Expensive</li> <li>The PGT can refuse the role of committee of estate if the adult has limited funds (as fees are incurred)</li> <li>Takes up to a year to complete</li> <li>Difficult to reverse</li> </ul>

Committee of person	Incapable     (Declared mentally incompetent by a judge)	Health care and personal care only
Committee of estate	○ Incapable	Financial/legal decisions only
