



Step 2: Standard ASD Screening Tools

ASD Screening Tool	Age Range	Administration
Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers – Revised/Follow-up (MCHAT-R/F)	16 to 30 months	Two-Stage: 5–10 minutes to complete a 20-item questionnaire. Then if required, 5–10 minutes to complete a follow-up interview.
Infant Toddler Checklist (ITC)	8 to 24 months	5-10 minutes to complete 24 items
Systematic Observation of Red Flags (SORF)	12 to 36 months	Take a free webinar to learn how to conduct systematic observations virtually (video feed) or face to face. Then access <u>SORF resources</u> online.
Autism Spectrum Rating Scales*	2 to 15 years	5–20 minutes to complete 70 items
Social Responsiveness Scale – 2nd ed. Preschool (SRS-2)*: Four age groups: Preschool School Age Adult Adult Self-Report	Preschool: 2.5 years to 4.5 years School-Age: 4 to 18 years Adult: 19 years and older Adult Self-Report: 19 years and older	15–20 minutes to complete 65 items. Uses an automated scoring program
Social Communication Questionnaire (SCQ)* - Lifetime Form \$	4 to 40 years	10 minutes for parent or other primary caregiver to complete 40 yes/no questions.
Autism Quotient (AQ)	Age 16 +	10 minutes for adult to self-complete 50 items.
Autism Quotient-10 (AQ-10)	Age 16+	Less than 5 minutes for adult without a learning disability to complete 10-items
