ASD Screening Tool	Age Range	Administration
<a href="#">Modified Checklist for Autism in Toddlers – Revised/Follow-up (MCHAT-R/F)</a>	16 to 30 months	Two-Stage: 5–10 minutes to complete a 20-item questionnaire. Then if required, 5–10 minutes to complete a follow-up interview.
<a href="#">Infant Toddler Checklist (ITC)</a>	8 to 24 months	5-10 minutes to complete 24 items
<a href="#">Systematic Observation of Red Flags (SORF)</a>	12 to 36 months	Take a free webinar to learn how to conduct systematic observations virtually (video feed) or face to face. Then access <a href="#">SORF resources</a> online.
<a href="#">Autism Spectrum Rating Scales*</a>	2 to 15 years	5–20 minutes to complete 70 items
<p><a href="#">Social Responsiveness Scale – 2nd ed. Preschool (SRS-2)*:</a></p> <p><b>Four age groups:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preschool</li> <li>• School Age</li> <li>• Adult</li> <li>• Adult Self-Report</li> </ul>	<p><b>Preschool:</b> 2.5 years to 4.5 years  <b>School-Age:</b> 4 to 18 years  <b>Adult:</b> 19 years and older  <b>Adult Self-Report:</b> 19 years and older</p>	15–20 minutes to complete 65 items. Uses an automated scoring program
<a href="#">Social Communication Questionnaire (SCQ)* - Lifetime Form</a>	4 to 40 years	10 minutes for parent or other primary caregiver to complete 40 yes/no questions.
<a href="#">Autism Quotient (AQ)</a>	Age 16 +	10 minutes for adult to self-complete 50 items.
