In his role with the B.C. Patient Safety & Quality Council and Stroke Services of B.C, Dr. Harris has led a provincial stroke collaborative that brought together clinicians, administrators, a stroke survivor and quality improvement specialists to improve the care of stroke and transient ischemic attack patients. Through knowledge translation, quality improvement and academic evaluation, Dr. Harris has successfully created a culture of knowledge exchange that has led to policy and legislative changes.
