Dr. Bennett spearheaded the use of simulation in her courses, and oversaw the design, building and equipping of the BC Children's Hospital Simulation Center (2013). Dr. Greig established the Internationally Educated Physiotherapist Exam Preparation (IEPEP) Program, which supports Internationally Educated Physiotherapists (IEPs) through the most difficult of the Canadian physiotherapy licensing requirements — the national exams. It was the first program of its kind in Canada, and it provides an exceptional Continuing Professional Development experience for its participants through innovative program delivery; development of novel teaching and learning resources; and a commitment to ongoing Program improvement and evaluation. In its short existence, the IEPEP Program has offered national exam preparation opportunities to over 450 IEPs from more than 25 different countries worldwide.
